CHANGE OF MENGO ELITE LEAGUE (MEL) PLAYING FORMAT

A. First Half of the Competition

- 1. In the first half of the Competition each team will be required to play 11 games. This means that, all the teams will play each other once.
- 2. In the previous outings of the First Half of the Season, teams have each been playing 2 games per outing but moving forward, each team will play 3 games per outing.
- 3. At the end of the first half, a representative or captain from each of the top 8 teams of the League will then be invited to hold a draw that will then decide the couplings for the quarter finals.
 - a. There will be (2) pots set-up
 - i. Pot 1 will have the top 4 teams
 - ii. Pot 2 will have the next 4 teams
 - b. Teams will then be drawn to make pairs
 - c. The first team selected will be the home team and will be allowed to select the pitch to play on.
- 4. When the draw has been made then a day will be communicated for when the games will be played.

B. Second Half of the competition

- 1. In the Second Half of the Season, the League will be played in a tournament system.
- 2. The pairs arising out of the draws made on the last outing of the First Half of the Season will play on the final & last outing of the MEL Season in quarters, semis and finals where the ultimate winner of the League will emerge.
- 3. This means that on the final outing of the Season, quarters, semis and finals will be played by the top 8 teams of the League.
